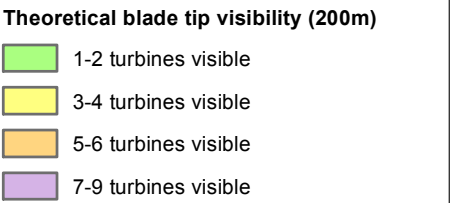


Notes:
 The ZTV is calculated to blade tip height (200m/180m) from a viewing height of 2m above ground level. The terrain model assumes bare ground and is derived from OS Terrain 50 height data (obtained from Ordnance Survey in January 2023). Earth curvature and atmospheric refraction have been taken into account. The ZTV was calculated using ArcPro 3.0.3 software.
